Heritage Europe in association with the Mayor of Poitiers has pleasure in inviting you to participate in a study visit to the 2000 year old historic city of Poitiers.

This is an opportunity to visit and study the "Coeur d'Agglo" – conceived by Yves Lion – an ambitious redesign of the 'public realm' in the historic centre of Poitiers. It is perhaps the most



recent example of a comprehensive "makeover" of the streets of a historic city.

The project has:

- · highlighted the architectural heritage of Poitiers
- extended the pedestrian zone
- · expanded the retail offer of the city centre.
- created a new garden street "Puygarreau" linking the Prefecture to the City Hall.

This visit will be of interest to decision makers active in the sustainable management of historic towns including senior politicians and professionals in the fields of urban planning, landscape, sustainable transport, town centre management and tourism development.
